From the success of our first Model Village project in Karakert, impacting the lives of 5,000 villagers — 1,200 of them children — COAF has expanded to serve five more of Armenia's 900 villages. In less than three short years and with a modest budget of \$4 million leveraged with our partners, we were able to accomplish the following:


- Complete rebuilding of two fully equipped, modern kindergartens
- Complete reconstruction and renovation of three schools
- Construction of a state-of-the-art medical clinic
- Development of a village cultural center and a public park
- Construction of a modern water network and irrigation system
- Economic development program and training modules in five villages
- Creation of social and civic programs to help sustain COAF's implemented initiatives

Our development model, in partnership with village leaders and international donors, represents a unique formula that are now being applied to a growing cluster of villages desperately in need of our help. Our success has captured the imagination of development agencies, philanthropists and government officials throughout the world. Together, we have made a dramatic difference in a very short time.

As always, I invite you to see our progress in the faces of our children, in the stories they have to tell, and in the contributions their generation will make to the future of Armenia and the world.

Thank you for all you have done to build and to sustain COAF's vital work. There is no better investment we can make than in the future of our children.
